# 6.1 SB820 Application for Growth Funding

Deputy Superintendent of Business Services. Liann Reyes, asked to take action on the SB 820 Growth Funding Application which requires the signature of the board president. For funding consideration, this application must be submitted to CDE no later than November 6, 2020.

When the 2020-21 State Budget was approved, Senate Bill (SB) 98 provided local education agencies (LEAs) with a funding guarantee; the 2019-20 reported ADA would be used to calculate the 2020-21 funding. However, projected increases to enrollment and/or ADA would not be taken into consideration and would not be factored into 2020-21 funding calculations.

Education Code (EC) Section 43505(b)(1)(A), as amended by Senate Bill 820, Chapter 110, Statutes of 2020, provides eligible local educational agencies (LEAs) the opportunity to apply for funding based on projected growth in either enrollment or average attendance (ADA) for the 2020-21 fiscal year.

The Santa Cruz COE is eligible to apply for this funding since ADA growth was projected in the 2020-21 adopted budget due to the conversion of Cypress Charter High School to Cypress Community School under the Alternative Education program.

# 7.1 <u>Board Budget Workshop</u>

The Board received an informational presentation from Superintendent Sabbah and Deputy Superintendent of Business Services, Liann Reyes, regarding an overview of the Santa Cruz County Office of Education's historical financial information and future budget planning process.

The presentation detailed the Santa Cruz County Office of Education's unrestricted spending balances from over the last several years, K-12 apportionment deferrals, effects of cash deferrals on the typical apportionment schedule, the current and projected effects of COVID-19 on school revenue, and highlighted strategies to achieve a balanced budget. The presentation also explained the Santa Cruz County Office of Education's plan for zero-based budgeting and other financial planning for 2021-2022.

The Board asked a number of clarifying questions of Deputy Superintendent Reyes and County Superintendent Sabbah.
