The Santa Cruz County Office of Education student programs Learning Continuity Plan template memorializes the planning process already underway for the 2020–21 school year and includes descriptions of the following: conducting meaningful stakeholder engagement; maintaining transparency; addressing the needs of unduplicated pupils, students with unique needs, and students experiencing homelessness; providing access to necessary devices and connectivity for distance learning; providing resources and supports to address student and staff mental health and social emotional well-being; and continuing to provide school meals for students. The Board conducted a public hearing to determine the level of interest and support from community members, teachers, and students of the district.

President Roth opened the public hearing and explained the procedure of the hearing.

Superintendent Sabbah gave a brief introduction of the Learning Continuity Plan and introduced Jennifer-Izant Gonzales, Alternative Education Project Coordinator.
