8.1 <u>2017-2018 Fiscal Year Annual Report</u>

Terri Montgomery, Partner, Vavrinek, Trine, Day & Co., LLP presented to the Board the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year Annual Audit Report as of June 30, 2018. Ms. Montgomery highlighted many different areas throughout the report and concluded that the audit was found to have been presented fairly with findings no federal or state findings, no adjustments, and that both federal and state funds were unmodified.

Trustee Van Allen questioned Ms. Montgomery how Vavrinek, Trine, Day & Co., LLP distributes the hours required to produce the Annual Audit Report. Ms. Montgomery replied that her team accrues the bulk of the time required to produce the report by holding three, one-week informational gathering sessions at the COE throughout the year.

Trustee Filicetti asked how long Ms. Montgomery has personally been conducting the COE audit and how long her company has been conducting the COE audit. Ms. Montgomery stated that the Ed. Code requires the partner conducting the Audit to rotate every six years. She has been personally auditing the COE for a total of seven years, and could not precisely recall the specific number of years that Vavrinek, Trine, Day, & Co., LLP has been performing the company audit.

Trustee Filicetti also questioned whether the OPEB represents the retiree's medical benefits. Ms. Montgomery confirmed this to be true.

Superintendent Sabbah commended Mary Hart and the entire Business Services team for their hard work and successful audit.

9.1 <u>Cypress Charter Proposal</u>
