Learn

- listen to a family story
- listen to a book read aloud
- read a book
- attend church services in target language
- ask your parent or other language expert to teach you words/phrases
- learn a song or poem
- take a language class
- learn basics like numbers, colors, common courtesy words
- learn a game, sport, dance or other activity
- follow directions to make something
- watch an age-appropriate video, movie or TV show

Speak

- tell your family about what you are learning in school
- take a trip to a country where they speak the language
- attend a community event where people are using target language
- work on a project with someone older (build something, fix something, clean something, create something)
- communicate with an adult or older child who is caring for you
- help another child communicate on the playground or in the community
- host relatives or visitors from other countries with your family
- use target language to ask for help in a store, restaurant, or library (with adult present)
- talk to someone on the phone (Facetime/Skype)
- talk to your parents about the value of knowing more than one language
- be a buddy for a new student
- cook something with an adult/older child

Lead

- draw a picture about something that happened to you and tell your family about it
- tell a story
- write a book
- pretend to be a firefighter, scientist, mother, doctor, child, superhero, etc. using the target language
- present/perform at a school or community "recital" or event
- create an illustrated personal multilingual dictionary
- sing a song or recite a poem to your family
- teach someone a game
- teach someone how to say courtesy words (hello, goodbye, please and thank you)
