OVERVIEW:

LRM is a free annual family engagement conference. At the 7th annual 2017 LRM we hosted 320 students and family members from Santa Cruz County with 50 volunteers. Our audience is middle, high school, and college students and their families. The event is conducted entirely in Spanish with English translation and includes speakers, workshops, and information tables.

- We will eliminate the achievement gaps that currently exist between demographic groups within the SCCS student community.

EVIDENCE OF IMPACT:

When surveyed, 4th and 8th grade students don't know the breadth of opportunities open to them. Exposing students to careers and personal academic journeys helps them see what is possible for their futures. LRM attendance has grown over the years. Students and families report being well-informed and inspired.

- Honor Latino teachers nominated by their students in Santa Cruz County
- More free bus transportation from south county
- Separate workshops for students and adults
- Expanded partnership with Santa Cruz College Commitment
