



Student Leadership Group: Facilitating Math Learning

Helping others to discover and cultivate wonder and joy in mathematics can be satisfying and fulfilling. It can also provide a context for high school students to **learn important life-skills** such as:

- Empathy and listening skills
- Leadership and problem-solving skills
- Practical job skills: tutoring, teaching, facilitating, leadership

High school students participating in the **Student Leadership Group: Facilitating Math Learning** will learn and practice leadership and facilitation skills that they will use to support younger students to:

- Challenge themselves with new math problems and puzzles
- Feel safer to share their ideas and strategies with others, and with increased confidence

During this Network, participating students will:

- Collaboratively challenge ourselves with fun math problems/puzzles
- Learn and practice strategies to facilitate math-focused learning with other students
- Plan and facilitate a County-wide **Mini-Math Festival** at the **STEAM Expo on Saturday, March, 11 2023**

The Network will meet:

- Monthly on Zoom 3:30-4:30: Thursday September 15, October 12, November 14, December 15, January 18, February 28, as well as an in-person date in Winter, 2023
- We will co-design and co-facilitate a **"Mini Math Festival"** at the STEAM Expo, Saturday March 11
