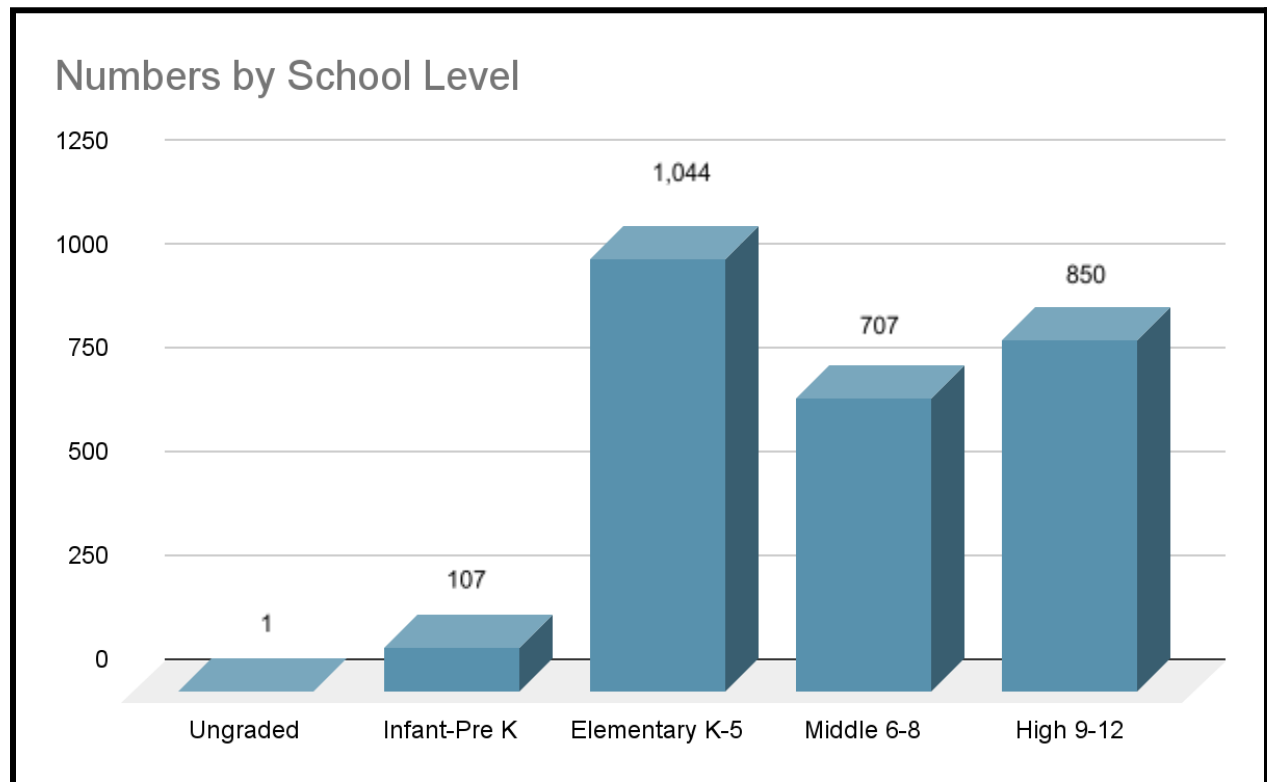

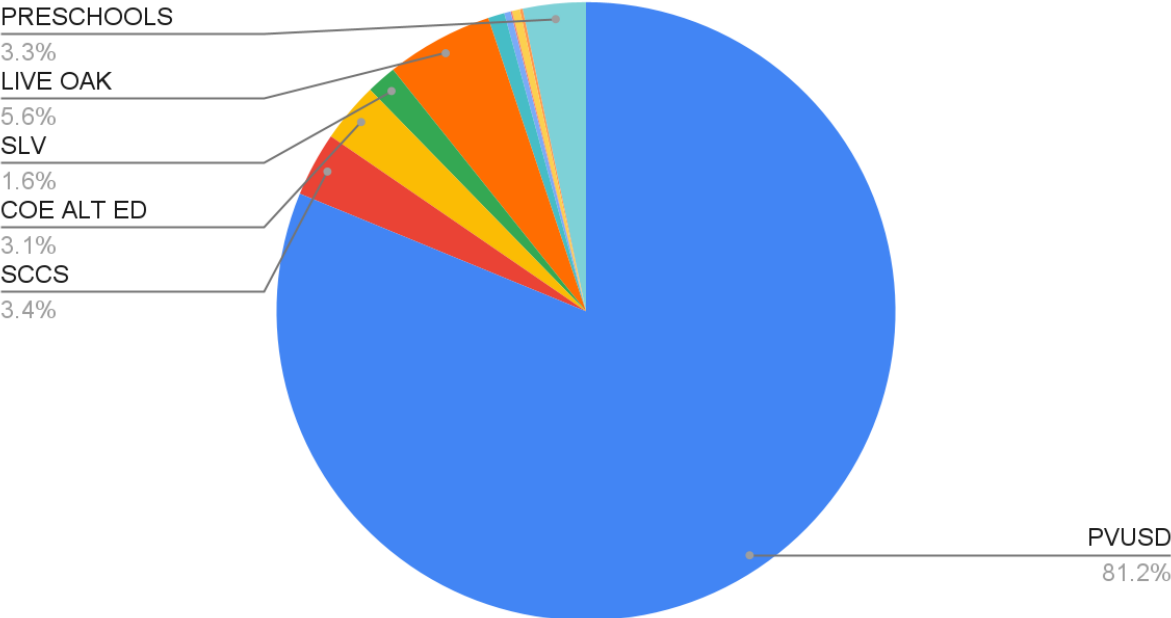

Top 5 District Needs	Actions Taken
Staff professional development and awareness of homeless issues	Increase offering in-person/virtual training options to all districts, At-Promise Students CoP
Referrals for medical, dental, and other health services	Outreach and connection with CBO's and other health providers
Addressing needs related to domestic violence	Closer collaboration with Community Based Organizations - Shelter Collaborative
Parent education related to rights and resources for homeless children	Purchase parent-focused materials for LEAs to distribute
Transportation	Utilize ARP funds for transportation support
