## ABOUT THE CLASS

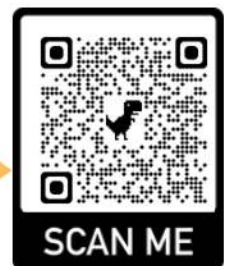
