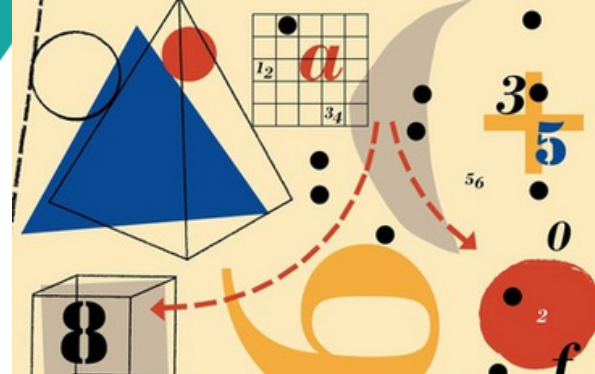

## Who Can Participate?

Students enrolled in Santa Cruz County public and private schools, **grades 5 through 8** are invited to participate. The contest is designed to be a **challenging and positive experience** for interested students.

## How Can Students Participate?

- Identify a Lead Teacher at the school to sign up a team (minimum 3, maximum 5 students)
- **TEACHER WILL REGISTER STUDENTS FOR BOTH THE TEAM AND INDIVIDUAL CONTEST**
- Team Contest: 3 to 5 students from the same school and grade span a working together
- Individual Contest: Each student works individually

## All participating schools must:

Appoint a **LEAD TEACHER** who will register students and coordinate teacher/parent proctors who help the day of the contest. **Lead Teacher must also serve as Reader/Grader on the day of the contest.**
